

## 2010 KIRKBY LONSDALE MOTOR CLUB STAGE RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP

### REGULATIONS

#### 1. ANNOUNCEMENT.

Kirkby Lonsdale Motor Club, in conjunction with [www.evoparts.org](http://www.evoparts.org) will promote a Stage Rally Championship comprising a range of National B stage rallies. The Championship will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association, incorporating the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A. and any written instructions that the club may issue for the Championship.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY

The Championship will only be open to full members of Kirkby Lonsdale Motor Club who will be automatically registered for the Championship on payment of Club membership fees of £10 per person (subject to confirmation following the Annual General Meeting of KLMC in April). There will be no further Championship Registration fee. A Championship registration form needs to be completed for all members wanting to be allocated points, no fee required.

#### 3. COMPETITORS

Contenders should enter Championship events under the KLMC name (Multiple club entries will be acceptable for crews competing in other club championships), and preferably attach 2no. Championship Decals to the car. These should be visible from both sides of the car at all times. Decals will be provided free of charge as required.

#### 4. CLASSES

There will be 4 classes as follows:

- A. Cars with an engine capacity up to and including 1400cc.
- B. Cars with an engine capacity over 1400 up to and including 1700cc.
- C. Cars with an engine capacity over 1700 up to and including 2100cc.
- D. Cars with an engine capacity over 2100cc and all 4WD and Turbo Charged cars.

#### 5. SCORING

The Championship will consist of a maximum of seventeen rounds including a bonus event, with the best seven scores to count. To be eligible for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> awards, the competitors need to have scored points on at least two forest and two non-forest rounds. (If for any reason any of the qualifying rounds do not run, other events may be substituted or the number of scoring rounds reduced subject to official notification.) Points will be awarded as follows:

- a. 15 points for 1<sup>st</sup> KLMC driver and KLMC co-driver in overall classification, down to 1 point for 15<sup>th</sup> KLMC driver and KLMC co-driver in overall event classification.
- b. 10 points for 1<sup>st</sup> KLMC driver and KLMC co-driver in each class, down to 1 point for 10<sup>th</sup> KLMC driver and KLMC co-driver in each Championship capacity class.
- c. 10 points for 1<sup>st</sup> KLMC finisher overall down to 1 point for the 10<sup>th</sup> KLMC finisher overall on each section of the Tour of Mull. (The "Trophy Rally" results will not count, neither will class positions).
- d. Every Championship contender starting a Championship round will score a minimum of one point and a minimum of 3 points for starting all sections of the Tour of Mull, the bonus

event. Competitors not contesting the Tour of Mull can nominate one other event to count as long as results are provided to the Championship committee.

Championship scores will be gained by adding all of the above together. The competitor with the highest total from six rounds will win. Drivers and co-drivers will score points separately and individually, i.e. one crew member does not have to be a member of KLMC for the other to score points, however, Championship decals should preferably be carried on the car.

In the event of a tie, equal Championship positions and annual Awards will be given.

#### 6. AGREEMENT

All contenders must agree to abide by these Championship Regulations.

#### 7. DISPUTES

Any query regarding these Regulations should be addressed to the Championship Secretary.

Any disputes or judicial matters will be dealt with in accordance with the MSA General Regulations Section O.

#### 8. BULLETINS

The Official Bulletin of the Championship will be the KLMC monthly Newsletter. Tabulated results will be included in each Newsletter following as soon as practicable after each event. They will also be available on [www.klmc.org.uk](http://www.klmc.org.uk).

#### 9. ENTRIES

The onus is on the competitor to obtain regulations and entries for Championship rounds and KLMC accept no responsibility for failure to have an entry accepted.

#### 10. AWARDS

Awards will be presented at the KLMC Annual Dinner Dance in 2011 as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> Overall Driver:	The PRESIDENTIAL TROPHY and Replica Award
1 <sup>st</sup> Overall Co-driver:	The LONSDALE CHALLENGE TROPHY and Replica Award
2 <sup>nd</sup> Overall Driver:	The KLMC CHALLENGE TROPHY and Replica Award
2 <sup>nd</sup> Overall Co-driver:	The KLMC CHALLENGE TROPHY and Replica Award
3 <sup>rd</sup> Overall Driver:	The KLMC MILLENIUM TROPHY and Replica Award
3 <sup>rd</sup> Overall Co-driver:	The KLMC MILLENIUM TROPHY and Replica Award

1st in each engine capacity class: Awards to Driver and Co-Driver

No Contender may win more than one of the above awards.

N.B Contenders must start at least two Championship events in the same engine capacity class to be eligible for any awards.

#### BONUS AWARDS:

The KLMC Driver and Co-Driver scoring the most points on five Forest Events in the Championship:

**SPECIAL AWARDS:**

The ARI VATANEN TROPHY and Replica Award to 'the fastest man between accidents'

The PISTON BROKE TROPHY to the unluckiest Driver in the Championship.  
The NEIL MASHITER SERVICE CREW AWARD to the most deserving person or persons.

The PERSONALITY AWARD and Replica Award to the person who makes a significant contribution to the Championship.  
(For Drivers, Co-Drivers, Service Crews, Marshals - anyone is eligible).
